



## Dance Etiquette and Dress Code

The following has been adopted by this club and is intended to give us the most enjoyable dance experience possible.

1. All dances that circulate the floor shall be danced in a counterclockwise line of dance, such as Fox Trot, Waltz, Polka, and Quick Step. Those couples that dance more slowly should progress around the floor closer to the center, leaving the outermost portion for those taking longer steps.
2. Spot dances may be danced at any place on the floor, such as Cha Cha, Rhumba, East and West Coast Swing.
3. For dances which can be danced either by circulating or by maintaining one spot on the floor, the center most portion of the floor shall be reserved for the spot dancers and the periphery for those circulating. For example, a Fox Trot that can also be danced as a Swing. Also when a particular maneuver requires that you stay in place which would impede the line of dance, move toward the center of the floor.
4. Line dancing will be permitted only when specifically announced by the DJ or the master of ceremonies.
5. Please do not congregate on the dance floor when a dance is in progress.
6. Normal dress code will be Smart Casual.
  - Men: Dress slacks and collared sport shirt or turtleneck  
Coat and tie optional
  - Ladies: Dresses or dressy slacks
  - Certain dances may be specified, such as Formal, Hawaiian, Halloween, etc. Proper notice will be given for these events.
